The Consumer Product Safety Information Act of 2008 (CPSIA)

(Information for operators of AnaJet printers)

CPSIA law went into effect on February 10, 2008. It relates to the protection of children's toys and childcare articles, primarily intended for children 12 years or younger. It specifically cites the lead and phthalate contents. According to the trade organization, SGIA, CPSC does not consider children's apparel to be a toy, but certain apparel items (used of sleep and eating for instance) to be childcare article.

It is our understanding that the operators of AnaJet printers will be largely unaffected. The exception would be items intended for a child 3 years of age or younger that are specifically to be used during eating or sleeping. This would include items like baby bibs, blankets and infant pajamas. Items like these would need to meet the new law standards. To meet the standards, items produced need to have less than the specified maximum parts per million of Lead and Phthalates. To our knowledge neither Lead nor Phthalates are added to AnaBright ink or to the ink's constituent parts. We are currently waiting for AnaJet's ink manufacturers to provide us with testing information. As no standard testing has been defined by the legislation, there may be a delay for clarification from the government. The CPSIA's testing and certification requirement has been pushed back for one year, but starting February 10th, 2009 items sold would need to meet the new regulation standard. The certification must be for the finished products being sold by the retailer by the final finished item producers per the CPSIA law. So AnaJet or ink maker cannot certify the garments or other completed items for you. Nor can AnaJet certify that the inks and other consumable materials supplied will make the end items compliant per the law. We can only provide data needed by you. Because the current statute is not clearly defined, we expect that more clarification from the government will come shortly to make your process easy.
